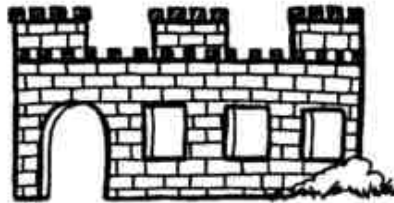


*You captured an enemy spy
